New and improved surface on Budweg Calipers



According to EU ELV directive (Directive 2000/53/EC of The European Parliament and of The Council of 18 September 2000 on End-of Life Vehicles) the content of hexavalent chromium, lead, mercury and cadmium in vehicles and their components and materials shall be limited to absolute minimum, and use of hexavalent chromium in surface treatments will be forbidden from July the 1st 2007.

Budweg Caliper A/S is a remanufacturing company with huge consideration for nature and safety and will, as the first company in the business, from November 1st 2004 no longer use hexavalent chromium in surface treatments of calipers. Shortly the surface treatment of spare parts will also be free of hexavalent chromium.

In future the calipers from Budweg Caliper A/S will have a natural bright zinc colour and be slightly iridescent instead of the golden surface.

The new surface provides better corrosion resistance than the old surface. The new process is also more environmentally friendly. As long as we have calipers with the golden surface in stock you will receive these.
